



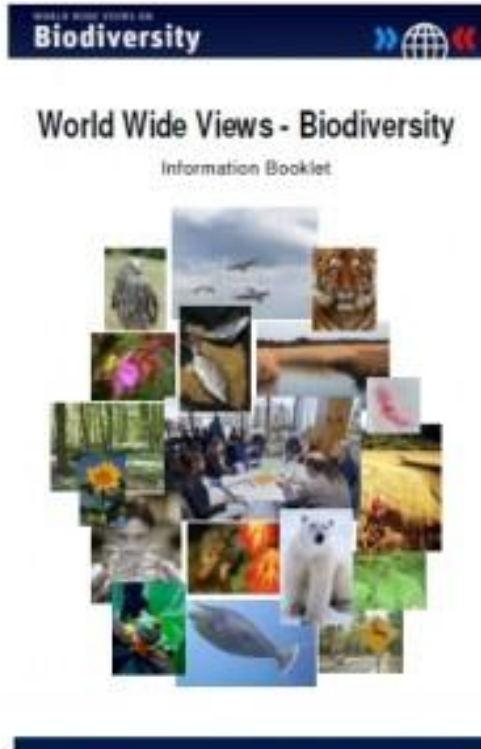

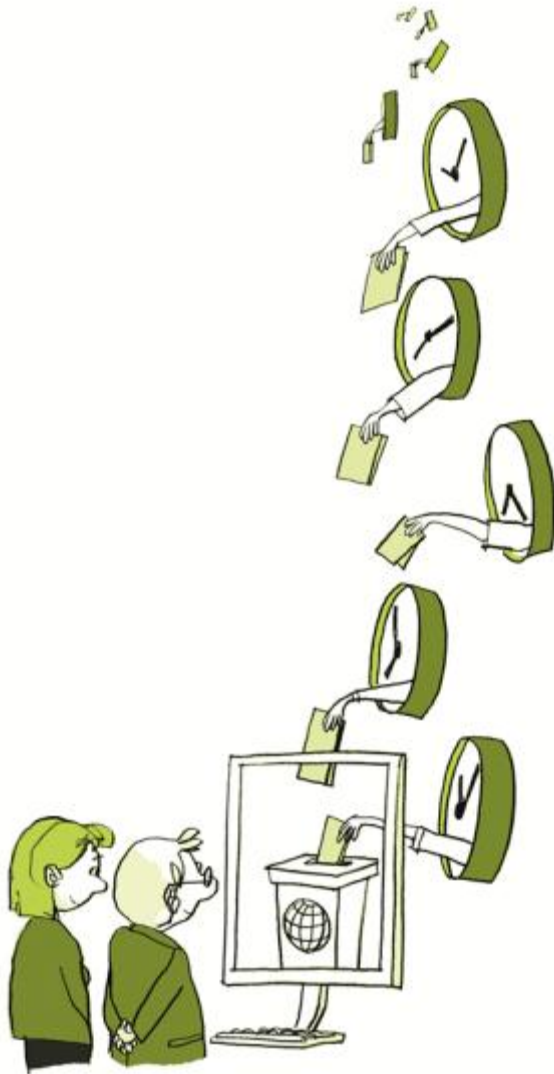

- Cost effective





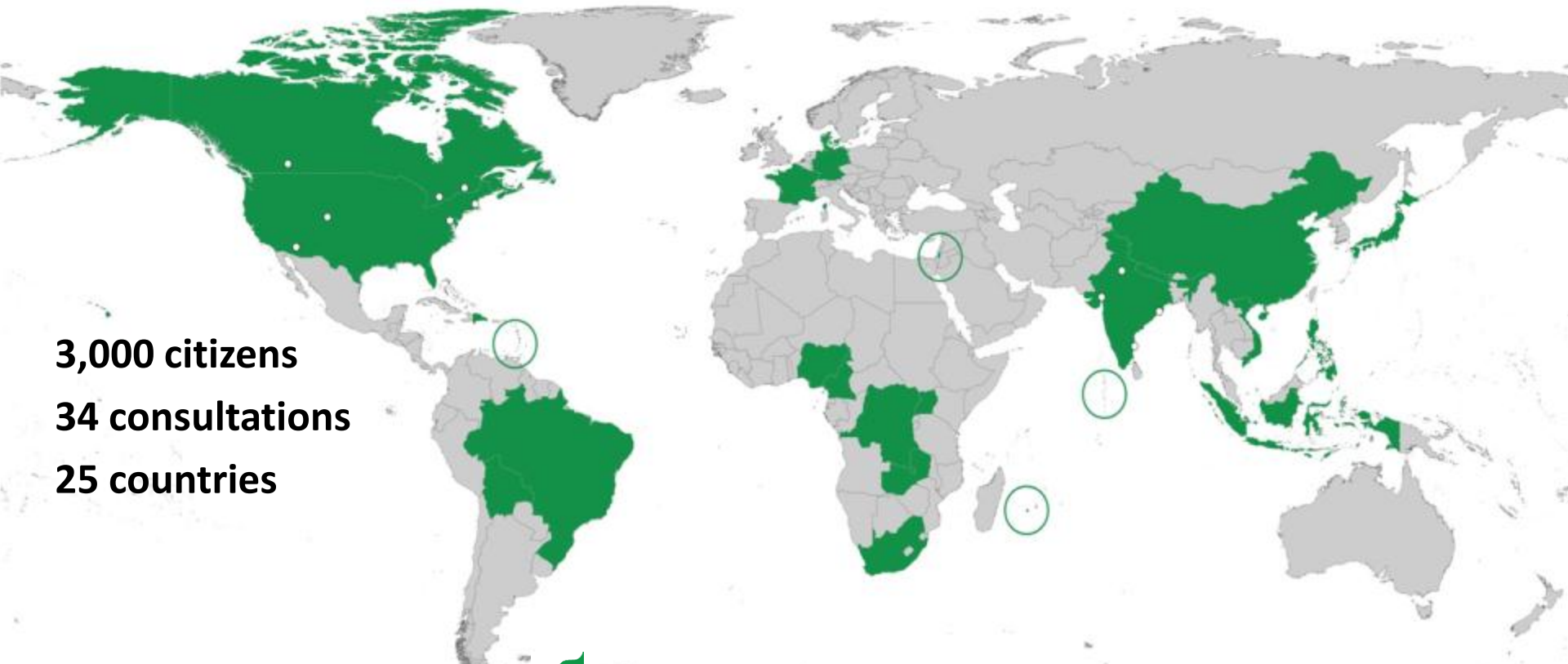
